- Especially important to the board is your feedback on the playlist. Each table will have several copies of the entire playlist with a 1-4 rating checkbox for each song. Each song will announce what dance it is leading into so you can use the playlist to keep track and make sure you don't miss your favorites. Tell us which ones you love and which ones you hate and write in your missing favorites on the back to make our music better suit you.

- Thank you to the 43 couples that paid their \$60 membership fee to become paid members. The privilege of membership, besides getting a \$20 discount on each dance, is that you can self register online and have seating choice. By definition and by our bylaws, if you are not a paid member you are a guest and must be invited by a member to attend a dance. Members can easily register guest couples to sit at their table online or fill out the paper guest registration forms and mail them in.
- Dance registration is by table. Any paid member can register for the next dance at any time online. Once you do, tell your member friends what table to request so they can select that on their online or paper registration form to sit with you. - Remember, even though you picked a table for you (and your guests), members can login online and move themselves (and their guests) to different tables any time. Just click on the Seating link at the top of any web page and click the 'Move me...' link to any table that has room for you (and your guests).
- If no one in your table group can register online you can annotate whom you want to sit with on your mail-in registration form. **Include the phone numbers of everyone that has confirmed they will attend that you want to sit with on the registration form so we can call you all to coordinate. The sooner you register, the more likely you will get your preference.**
